"The Faith of Jesus in a Pluralistic World" - This series investigates how Christians may hold a particular belief in Jesus as the Christ of God amidst a world of competing religious claims. World-class scholars will help us process and learn about how Jesus Christ can be the "way, the truth, and the life," without condemning other people's religious beliefs and values. The central question of this series is how is Christianity related to other faith traditions?
